Alexis

Sparland Fire Protection District in Lacon, IL, has put in service a tanker powered by a Caterpillar CAT CT660S cab and chassis built by Alexis Fire Equipment Company. It's the second piece of fire apparatus to be built using a Caterpillar cab, chassis and running gear. It's powered by a Caterpillar CT 410-hp engine and a Caterpillar CX31 transmission. Alexis built the aluminum body and equipped the rig with a Waterous CLVK 500-gpm pump and a 3,500-gallon elliptical poly tank with stainless-steel wrap. It also has ROM roll-up doors, six Whelen 12-volt LED scene lights (two on each side and two on the rear), Akron Extenda-Lite 220-watt brow light and Whelen LED emergency warning lights. Bordens Hose Company No. 1 in Mount Upton, NY, has received a mini attack pumper built on a 2015 Ford F550 cab and chassis by Danko. The Quick Response Attack Mini-Pumper has a four-door, five-occupant climate-controlled cab, Ford Diesel engine, and a 5-speed automatic transmission. To fight fire, it has a Hale DSD75-19L single-stage pump, 350-gallon UPF Poly Tank III water tank, FRC InControl 400 pressure governor, ROM shutters, Kussmaul auto-eject charging system, LED compartment lighting, Holmatro extrication tools and LED warning lights. Darley

The Amenia, NY, Fire District No.1 has taken delivery of a new Darley Auto-CAFS pumper built on an all-wheel drive Spartan 4-door chassis. It has a 450-hp Cummins ISL 9 engine and an Allison 3000EVS transmission. The Compressed Air Foam System is piped to supply water, foam solution, CAFS, or even plain compressed air to four discharges, including the front and middle 1½-inch crosslays, a rear 2½-inch crosslay and the deck gun. ROM roll-up doors and aluminum diamond-plate garnish the copolymer "PolyBilt" body. The ladders and pike poles are stored in a slide-in rear compartment. The integrated copolymer water tank holds 1,030 gallons of water and 30 gallons of Class A foam in its integral foam tank. A Will-Burt Night Scan telescoping light is mounted on top of the vehicle in a pocket at the front of the hosebed for providing overhead scene illumination. darley.com



E-ONE has delivered to the Chicago Fire Department a specialized pumper put in service at O'Hare International Airport. It's built on an E-ONE Cyclone cab and chassis powered by a Cummins ISX 12 450-hp engine and an Allison 4000EVS transmission. To fight fire, it has a Hale QMax 2,000-gpm single-stage pump, a 1,030-gallon water tank with a 250-gallon Class B foam tank, and a Williams Hot Shot 150 foam system. Port Crane, NY, Volunteer Fire Department recently took delivery of a Firovac tanker/pumper. Designed to provide the most efficient use of both water and personnel, the apparatus is equipped with a 3,000-gallon aluminum tank, three air-operated water valves, a Firovac power-down portable tank bracket with two tanks and a 1,000-gpm Darley fire pump with "pump-and-roll" capabilities, all on an International 7600 chassis. It also features an unprecedented vacuum water movement system, which not only self-loads quickly, but unloads under pressure. The apparatus comes with a "zero loss" ISO rating.

Sumter County Fire & Rescue (SCFR) in Sumter County, GA, recently took delivery of two 2015 Kenworth 3,000-gallon tankers. The tankers were manufactured by Fouts Brothers. These tankers will allow SCFR the capabilities to deliver large amounts of water from a water source to a fire scene where there are no fixed water systems (hydrants). The delivery of these tankers is part of an apparatus replacement program and is the first in a series of additional apparatus that will be delivered to SCFR over the next few months. They are also equipped with Darley LSP 1,000-gpm pumps, three Whelen PS Tank level gauges, Optimo rear camera systems with GPS-7101 and Federal Q2B sirens.

Danville, VA, Fire Department's nine-compartment truck is mounted on a Kenworth T370 and features 40-inch-deep compartments floor-to-ceiling forward of rear wheels, four roof storage compartments, Speedi-Dry hopper, Onan 25,000-watt generator and two cord reels with 200-foot-long 10/4 cable. It also includes Whelen Pioneer LED upper side body and rear flood lights, two Whelen Pioneer LED tripods, a Will-Burt Night Scan Powerlite light tower with six Whelen Pioneer LED floods, 7.9-cubic-foot electric air compressor with reels and fold-down step platforms. hackneyev.com

Centerville Fire District of Saugerties, NY, has recently taken delivery of a KME Eliminator tanker, built on a Freightliner M2 112 chassis that features a Detroit DD13 450-hp engine with a 3,000-gallon UPF Poly water tank and a Hale DSD 1,250-gpm pump. Other features include Newton electric rear dump valve, Whelen emergency and scene lighting, ROM roll-up doors, dual Akron direct tank fills, and 3,000-gallon Fol-Da-Tank. 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


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

Ladder Tower Co. has delivered the first newly upgraded 65-foot TeleSqurt telescoping aerial boom to Medina, OH, Fire Department. This versatile aerial has a 65-foot vertical and a 60-foot horizontal reach. The three-section boom



provides for a 199-inch wheelbase and minimal overhang. Dual A-frame-style stabilizers provide maximum stability and an 11-foot, 9-inch spread. Smeal's QL-12 multiplex electrical system, electric-over-hydraulic joystick control and LED lighting are standard. This TeleSqurt is equipped with a 1,500-gpm Waterous CMXC20 pump, 750-gallon water tank and is capable of flowing 1,000 gpm at the tip. Fold-down handrails provide travel height of just 11-feet, 9-inches. Medina's new TeleSqurt rides on a Smeal Sirius chassis.

The Manawa, WI, Rural Fire Department has a new engine built by Marion Body Works, Inc. on a Spartan Metro Star cab and chassis. The apparatus is equipped with a four-door, six-seat climate controlled cab, and 20-inch raised roof with rear cab modification. It is powered by a Cummins ISL 450-hp engine, and an Allison 3000EVS transmission. To fight fire, it has a Hale Qmax-XS 1,500-gpm pump and 750-gallon tank with a 20-gallon foam cell. Other equipment includes wireless headsets in the cab, EMS and overhead compartments, SIM-PLEX multiplexing touch screen switching and front and side scene lights. The body has full-depth rescue-style compartments, roof storage compartments, oil dry hopper, Stallion Air Auto Fill cascade system,

Midwest Fire


Chazy, NY, Fire Department has taken delivery of a Midwest Fire side-control tanker-pumper built on a Freightliner M2 106 chassis. The unit has a 3,000-gallon APR polypropylene tank, 1,000-gpm Darley LSP PTO pump, a 4-inch Storz Direct Tank Fill and one 5-inch Storz direct tank fill with tank level gauge. It also has two side and one rear stainless-steel Newton electric 10-inch square dump valves with 36-inch telescoping chutes, stainless steel "tip-down" portable tank carrier and 3,000-gallon portable tank. The vehicle features All-POLY Construction, "sweep-out" style compartments, including ROM anodized aluminum roll-up doors, door-activated LED light-

ing, vents, floor dry decking, NFPA-compliant LED-lighted folding steps and grab rails, six Whelen scene lights, full-width and length hosebed, pre-connected hose crosslays, adjustable ¾-inch polypropylene dividers and hose covers and Kussmaul battery charger with auto eject.

This Pierce Arrow XT vehicle, outfitted with the Oshkosh-exclusive Snozzle High-Reach Extendable Turret (HRET), is on duty with the Malaga Volunteer Fire Department in Eddy County, NM. Since going into service, the apparatus has proven itself in several emergency responses, protecting crude oil pumping and storage facilities located throughout southern New Mexico and West Texas. The apparatus features TAK-4 independent front suspension, a Husky 12 single-agent foam system, a 1,250-gallon poly water tank and a 200-gallon foam cell. The Oshkosh Snozzle HRET features a 50-foot reach.



Rosenbauer A

Rosenbauer America has built its first-ever 125-foot SMART Viper aerial ladder for the city of Sioux Falls, SD, Fire Rescue, making this aerial the longest that Rosenbauer America has produced. The five-section, hot-dipped galvanized, painted ladder has manual outrigger controls, a sealed cable valve control lever bank, a Rosenbauer-exclusive Green Star Idle Reduction Technology system, joystick aerial operation controls, an FX 3/16-inch aluminum body and a SMART Screen operation panel, all on a Rosenbauer Commander 4000 chassis. 


Spartan ERV A
